Decision to Play Non-Contact Games During Recess, Gym and Before/Aftercare

Beacon Christian Academy has agreed to allow the children designated times to play. All activities and games conducted during **Recess/ Gym/ Before Care/ After Care** will be NON-CONTACT (Stationary Exercises, Mother May I, Simon Says, Red Light Green Light, etc.).¹ If you have concerns about your child participating in **Recess/ Gym/ Before Care/ After Care**, and choose to opt-out, your child will be given activities to do at the lunchroom tables (coloring, puzzles, reading, etc.).² If there is a resurgence of the pandemic or if other health concerns arise, however, this may change.

Risks of Opting to Allow Your Child to Participate

You, the parent, understand that by opting to have your child participate in NON-CONTACT activities and games during **Recess/ Gym/ Before Care/ After Care**, you are assuming the risk of exposure to the coronavirus –or other public health risk. By signing this form, you, the parent, are making an informed decision and assuming the risk if your child becomes sick. You, the parent, will not hold Beacon Christian Academy liable if your child becomes sick.

K-4 Gym and Recess Consent Form

Beacon Christian Academy is taking the following precautions to protect our staff, students and families and help slow the spread of the coronavirus.

- Seating in the classroom and the lunchroom has been arranged for appropriate physical distancing.
- The BCA staff members are required to wear masks³ and/or face shields when not at their desks.
- The BCA staff maintains safe distancing.
- Restroom soap dispensers are maintained, and everyone is required to wash their hands.
- Hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol is available in the school office, in the classrooms, and in the lunchroom.
- We thoroughly sanitize all of the desks, tables, chairs, bathrooms, and other areas that are commonly touched after every use.
- Air filters are changed every 45 days.
- We have scheduled staggered drop off and pick up times for parents and their children to limit the contact the BCA community has with each other.
- Physical contact is not permitted.
- Tissues and trash bins are easily accessed. Trash is disposed of on a frequent basis.
- Common areas are thoroughly disinfected at the end of each day.
