received.



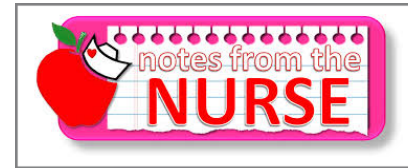
YES! We Are Also A CHURCH!
